#### White

#### Palazzo del Mare Cattaratto, Italy

Tropical fruits with a fresh nose and citrus, white blossom, and mandarins on the palate

## Vignerons de Valencay Sauvignon VdP du Val de Loire, France, 2020

This wine is very aromatic on the nose with notes of pineapple and apricot. It shows good mineral depths and intensity on the palate which make it a highly quaffable alternative that easily bears comparison with many a Sancerre. It has a fragrant nettle character on the palate, along with a crisp acidity on the dry finish.

## Domaine Bousquet Organic Chardonnay, Argentina, 2019

On the nose, it presents aromas of tropical fruits with citrus and floral notes. On the palate shows concentrated notes of peach and green apple with fresh acidity.

# Domaine Pierre Marchand Pouilly Fume, France, 2020

A complex example of a Pouilly Fumé with gooseberry and blackcurrant leaf on the nose. The palate has hints of citrus and apple. There is a long, elegant finish with a touch of minerality.

# Calusari Pinot Grigio, Romanian, 2021

A fabulous wine that can stand shoulder to shoulder with its peers from around the world.

Beautiful aromas of peach and grapefruit on the nose with loads of melon and apple on the palate.

## Mont Rocher Viognier Vieilles Vignes, Viognier, France, 2020

Hints of peaches and apricots, great alternative to Sauvignon without the harsh acidity, soft flavours but full of fruit and dry in style.

#### Mayfly Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand, 2020

A well-rounded Sauvignon Blanc, displaying intense lemon flavours with hints of lime. While the nose is subtle, this wine has a great richness, palate length and weight that provides huge flavour intensity on the finish.

# Domaine Sautereau Sancerre, France, 2020

This wine has a pale-yellow colour with an expressive and elegant nose. Aromas of citrus and gooseberry are complemented by floral and limestone notes which follow through on to the rounded palate. Medium-bodied with a crisp, saline finish.

#### Red

## Palazzo del Mare Nero d'Avola, Italy, 2020

Loads of ripe, plummy fruit with hints of liquorice, spice, red and cherry fruits. This wine is deliciously juicy and supple.

# Mont Rocher Carignan Vieilles Vignes, France, 2020

A lovely old vines Carignan with a richer style. On the nose, this juicy wine has masses of red berry fruit and notes of vanilla. Full of flavour but soft on the palate with a smooth finish.

### Tenuta Olim Bauda La Villa Barbera D'asti DOCG Piedmont, Italy, 2019

This wine is typified by a deep and bright ruby-red colour with a rich concentrated nose depicting cherry and berry fruit aromas. The palate is generous and full-bodied with a long and enticing finish.

### Bodegas Fabre Mendoza Phebus Gran Reserva Malbec, Argentina 2018

The nose has ripe black cherry fruit aromas with perfumed elegance from hints of violets and liquorice. The palate is smooth and rich, with plenty of dark fruit, layers of soft oak, and lighter floral notes.

#### Saint Marc, Merlot, France, 2020

Deliciously fruity with notes of thyme and pepper.

# Gatito Loco Organic Rioja Tinto, Spain, 2020

Made in Rioja, but not in the traditional style with no oak treatment. This cat has great freshness, crunchy bright red and black fruits. Juicy smooth finish.

### Chateau Vieux Ferrand Montagne St Emilion, France, 2016

Beautiful red plums and violets with some spicy and toasty notes. The palate is round and fleshy, with elegance and density. There are chocolate and mulberry flavours on the finish and effortless length.

# Chateau Gravette Lacombe, France, 2010

Lashings of blackberries and blackcurrants, with a smokey edge to the wine. Mellow tannins that are supple with long lasting finish.

#### Rose

#### Calusari Pinot Grigio Rose, Romania, 2020

A wonderful wine that can stand shoulder to shoulder with it's peers from around the world. A beautiful soft pink rose which is light but full of fresh strawberry and raspberry flavours with a gentle peppery finish. Dry and fruity with crisp acidity. A perfect, great value summer wine.

#### Guiessard Le Petit G Rose, France, 2020

Light cherry and peach notes with a hint of orange. Soft and easy drinking.

# Mont Rocher Cinsault Rose, France, 2020

This is a dry pale pink rosé, similar in style to a provence rosé. Soft red berry fruits, strawberry and raspberry flavours are supported by deliciously fresh acidity.

#### Sweet

### Lions de Suduiraut Sauternes, France, 2016 (37.5cl)

Honey nuts and a peach liqueur aroma, moving to sweet, spicy pineapple and peach notes on the palate.

#### Fizz

### Bei Tempi Prosecco Extra Dry, Italy

Brilliant light straw colour, brightened by a delicate perlage, zesty with citrus fruit and flowery features and a light fresh finish.

### Pierre Mignon Grande Reserve Premier Cru Champagne NV, France

From a small producer in Epernay this is a big wine with lots of white stone fruits, brioche and gentle very fine bubbles, great with canapes, fantastic way to celebrate.

#### BLO, Antech Cremant de Limoux, France

Aged traditionally and generously on its lees, this is a beautiful, balanced wine, with elegant aromas of orchard fruit and honeyed spice. The palate marries more exotic fruits with a clean, pebbly backdrop and an impressive depth of flavour.

# Bauget-Jouette Brut NV Champagne, France

This champagne has a fine, creamy mousse full of baked apple, fresh citrus and yellow flesh fruits such as pear and peach, finished with a touch of brioche.
